- 1 Dress professionally:**  
Even though you're attending the career day from the comfort of your home, it's important to dress professionally to make a good impression. Dress as you would for an in-person interview.
- 2 Test your technology:**  
Make sure your internet connection is stable and your camera and microphone are working correctly before the career day. You don't want to miss important conversations or opportunities because of technical issues.
- 3 Be prepared:**  
Research the companies and industries you're interested in before the career day. This will allow you to ask more informed questions and make a better impression on potential employers.
- 4 Review your CV:**  
To answer all the HR questions, take a look at your CV, and be sure of every skill that you mentioned.
- 5 Listen actively:**  
Pay attention to the speakers and take notes if necessary. This will help you remember important information and demonstrate your interest in the company or industry.
- 6 Engage with the speakers:**  
Participate in the sessions and ask thoughtful questions. This will show that you're engaged and interested in learning more about the industry or company.
- 7 Ask the HR good questions:**  
To show your interest, you should also prepare your questions. What qualities do you look for in a candidate when hiring for your company? Always show your interest.
- 8 Review our behavioural interview resources:**  
To avoid mistakes in the interviews, review the materials we shared before and search and practice the behavioural interviews question.
- 9 Stay aligned with the schedule and your turn:**  
Don't enter or join another room! Just review your name and the breakout room number you should have interviewed with before the event.
- 10 Follow up:**  
After the career day, send a thank you email to the speakers and any potential employers you spoke with. This will show that you appreciate their time and are serious about pursuing a career in their industry.
